

Dear Mr. XXXXX:

Please note that there are many verses in the Torah about killing, and I am talking about killing in what we categorize today as barbaric murder of people. Please note the following verse:

Bible- 1 Samuel: 15:1 Samuel said to Saul, "I am the one the LORD sent to anoint you king over his people Israel; so listen now to the message from the LORD. 2 This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'I will punish the Amalekites for what they did to Israel when they waylaid them as they came up from Egypt. 3 Now go, attack the Amalekites and totally destroy everything that belongs to them. Do not spare them; put to death men and women, children and infants, cattle and sheep, camels and donkeys.'"

But yet no one (rightfully) is accusing Jews and Christians of being terrorists. There is far less killing mentioned in the Koran, and in much less intensity than in the Torah and the rest of the books of the Old Testaments, but the whole world is (rightfully) condemning Islamic teachings as barbaric. This is not due to the Koran's bad teachings, but rather the teachings of the leaders who abuse the Koran. Even though the number of these leaders is small, their supporters comprise large numbers (but a small percentage of all Muslims).

So the Jewish religious leaders do not quote the above verses from the Bible and tell their followers at Saturday's prayer to go and kill all philistines, as we they were commanded to do throughout the Torah and the Old Testament – and they do not tell their followers they must not spare anybody. However, small groups of lost Muslims carry out these extreme principles, and unfortunately, the non-fanatic Muslims of the world, even though they do not agree with that amount of extremism, do not take an strong of stand against these type of evil as they should.

Furthermore, most of the Muslims carry a non-tolerance point of view toward the non-Muslim communities.

I am not suggesting all Muslims, but a very large portion of them maintain a negative attitude toward non-Muslims. For example, if anyone makes a joke about Prophet Mohammad, the fanatics are willing to risk their lives to kill the person who made that joke, while the rest of the Muslim communities generally don't condemn this type of reaction, although they criticize the person who made the joke. However the same

reaction is mission toward a suicide bomber who kills innocent people. The Koran does not condemn this strongly the person who even curses the Prophet Mohammad but it strongly opposes killings of the innocent people.

The extremist leaders Islam (i.e., the Osama Bin Laden's of the world) convince their followers to do evil by misquoting the Koran or taking verses out of their context, and when all these are not enough, they turn to other books that were written by people like themselves. Even though those books have nothing to do with the Koran, they quote them as if they were quoting the Koran.

Some of these books are very convincing to those who never read the Koran or other of God's books. Most of the people who are brainwashed by such writings are uneducated.

Please note the following three items:

- 1) There are many verses in the Koran and the Bible that commands their followers to kill.
- 2) There are also verses in the Koran and the Bible that offers heaven to those who die in the battle field fighting against God's enemies.
- 3) Heaven is defined in the Koran and the Bible.

The above puzzle pieces (verses about killing, heaven, and obedience) can be rearranged in any way if you were to take verses out of context and make a conclusion to your own liking.

Confused and dangerous minds like that of Osama Bin Laden do exactly that, and tell his barbaric but sometimes innocent followers to kill those who THEY identify as God's enemies. They brainwash their eager followers as they have been brainwashed themselves by (falsely) quoting the Koran that murderers of innocent people will go to heaven and find great food, wine, enjoyment, and above all plenty of beautiful virgins to satisfy their lust (exactly what they are craving in this life).

Most people know that these lost souls are brainwashed. I will show you the verses that they use out of context to do this evil act. Also note that the below verses taken out of context have the power to convert an innocent-hearted young mind to

become a so-called “suicide bomber.” I am quoting the below verses (out of context) to demonstrate this fact:

Koran 9:5 ..., then fight and slay the Pagans wherever ye find them, and seize them, beleaguer them, and lie in wait for them in every stratagem;

Koran 9:13 Fight them, and God will punish them by your hands, cover them with shame, help you over them, heal the breasts of Believers, ...

Koran 9:29 Fight those who believe not in God nor the Last Day, nor hold that forbidden which hath been forbidden by God and His Messenger, nor acknowledge the religion of Truth, ...

Koran 9:123 O ye who believe! fight the unbelievers ...

Koran 2:191 And slay them wherever ye catch them, and turn them out (of their houses)...

And then they quote the below verses about their reward:

Koran 55:46 But for such as fear the time when they will stand before (the Judgment Seat of) their Lord, there will be two Gardens- **47** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny?- **48** Containing all kinds (of trees and delights);- **49** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny?- **50** In them (each) will be two Springs flowing (free); **51** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny?- **52** In them will be Fruits of every kind, two and two. **53** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny? **54** They will recline on Carpets, whose inner linings will be of rich brocade: the Fruit of the Gardens will be near (and easy of reach). **55** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny? **56** In them will be (Maidens), chaste, restraining their glances, whom no man or Jinn before them has touched;- **57** Then which of the favours of your Lord will ye deny?- **58** Like unto Rubies and coral.

Koran 4:122 But those who believe and do deeds of righteousness,- we shall soon admit them to gardens, with rivers flowing beneath,-to dwell therein for ever. God's promise is the truth, and whose word can be truer than God's?

Truly only the Osama Bin Laden's of the world have the black magic to present the beautifulness as the reward to such an awful act.

Using the above verses out of place is not enough for these misguided people. They next start quoting other books that many men throughout history wrote with their own hand, and falsely said these works are from God. Those books are referred to as AHADITH, and they are full of verses about virgins and how, for example, one Ayatollah (Ayatollah Dast-Ghayb who was murdered) explains these virgins have breasts

as big as mountains and goes on and explains a more detailed and graphic explanations of heavenly women.

However, this is not going to prove that the Koran is commanding any of the above. To the contrary, the Koran is 100% aligned with the Torah, the New Gospel (Enjil), and all other books of the prophets (the Old Testament books).

The Koran simply says those who are good, whether they die naturally or accidentally, or when they are in battle, fighting for God, will go to heaven if they have performed good deeds. Now please note that the above verses about killing are all in retaliation to attacks, and if the verses before and after are quoted alongside, this point will be very clear (please refer to my book, *The Corruption of Moslem Minds*, to see that). Every verse that says “kill” in the Koran is describing the type of killing civilized countries carry on against people like Bin Laden. None is referring to suicide bombings of innocent people. There are many verses that forbids Muslims from killing innocent people.

Koran: 4:29 O ye who believe! Eat not up your property among yourselves in vanities: But let there be amongst you Traffic and trade by mutual good-will: Nor kill one another: for verily God hath been to you Most Merciful! **30** If any do that in rancor and injustice, soon shall We cast them into the Fire: And easy it is for God.

Koran: 4:92 Never should a believer kill a believer; but (If it so happens) by mistake, (Compensation is due): If one (so) kills a believer, it is ordained that he should free a believing slave, and pay compensation to the deceased's family, unless they remit it freely. If the deceased belonged to a people at war with you, and he was a believer, the freeing of a believing slave (Is enough). If he belonged to a people with whom ye have treaty of Mutual alliance, compensation should be paid to his family, and a believing slave be freed. For those who find this beyond their means, (is prescribed) a fast for two months running: by way of repentance to Allah: for Allah hath all knowledge and all wisdom.

Koran: 8:61 But if the enemy incline towards peace, do thou (also) incline towards peace, and trust in Allah: for He is One that heareth and knoweth (all things).

Koran: 5:32 On that account: We ordained for the Children of Israel that if any one slew a person - unless it be for murder or for spreading mischief in the land - it would be as if he slew the whole people: and if any one saved a life, it would be as if he saved the life of the whole people. Then although there came to them Our messengers with clear signs, yet, even after that, many of them continued to commit excesses in the land.

Please note in the above verses, God is clearly offering suicide bombers fire of hell, not virgins in heaven.

Furthermore, please note that Jews and Christians are clearly believers, and that fact is clearly stated in the Koran. Anyone with a mustard seed of knowledge about God's books knows that people of God and all the Prophets were Israelites, not Arabic. Arabs only had one Prophet, which was Prophet Mohammad, and according to the Koran he was just repeating God's previous books and correcting the few mistakes of Christians and Jews.

So for anyone to claim that God's message to Prophet Mohammad was to kill his own favorite people is absolutely nonsense and there is no proof from the Koran in this regard, but there are sufficient proof in contrast to this evil act of killing innocent people.

So yes, small groups of Muslims as a whole do get trained to kill innocent people, and yes, they are promised virgins. However, this is absolutely wrong according to the Koran. The Koran never teaches that you can pick and choose verses to convince foolish people to do evil acts in the name of God. One could even take this writing of mine now and pick a few statements out of context and interpret to a new meaning which could be exactly the opposite of what I am trying to say.

The Koran does promise many great things to men and women in the other world: Good food, good homes, and yes, a good wife or husband for marriage, but the requirement to get all these are good deeds and treating each other with outmost respect and nothing else.
