7) Even though the Koran acknowledges that Christians believe in a Trinity, and although the Koran does reject the Christian trinity, it claims that good Christians who rush to do good deeds are honorable people who God will reward.

Here is some of the verses from the Koran in regards to Christians.

Koran 3:113 They are not all the same; among the followers of the scripture (Jews and Christians), there are those who are righteous. They recite God's revelations through the night, and they fall prostrate. **114** They believe in God and the Last Day, they advocate righteousness and forbid evil, and they hasten to do righteous works. These are the righteous. **115** Any good they do will not go unrewarded. God is fully aware of the Any good they do will not go unrewarded. God is fully aware of the righteous.

Koran 3:33 God did choose Adam and Noah, the family of Abraham, and the family of 'Imran (family of Mary mother of Jesus) above all people,-

Koran 3:55 Thus, GOD said, "O Jesus, I am terminating your life, raising you to Me, and ridding you of the disbelievers. I will exalt those who follow you above those who disbelieve, till the Day of Resurrection.

Koran 29:46 Do not argue with the people of the scripture (Jews, Christians, and Muslims) except in the nicest possible manner

Even though the Koran states that the Christians are wrong for accepting Prophet Jesus Christ as God, but lay the blame on those who inserted these ideas into the Christianity many years ago. There are more verses in the Koran that can be celebrated today with those who accept one God, namely the Jews and the Christians. Koran tries to unite Muslims with the Children of Israel (Jews and Christians). For example Koran states that a Muslim who believes in one God must not marry a non-believer who does not believe in one God. But it clearly states that Muslim can marry Christians and Jews. Please note the verses:

Koran 5:5 Today, all good food is made lawful for you. The food of the people of the scripture is lawful for you. Also, you may marry the chaste women among the believers, as well as the chaste women among the followers of previous scripture, provided you pay them their due

dowries. You shall maintain chastity, not committing adultery, nor taking secret lovers. Anyone who rejects faith, all his work will be in vain, and in the Hereafter he will be with the losers.

Koran 2:221 Do not marry idolatresses unless they believe; a believing woman is better than an idolatress, even if you like her. Nor shall you give your daughters in marriage to idolatrous men, unless they believe. A believing man is better than an idolater, even if you like him. These invite to Hell, while GOD invites to Paradise and forgiveness, as He wills. He clarifies His revelations for the people, that they may take heed.

Also the Koran states that Muslims should tell the Jews and Christian, let us unite on worshiping and accepting one God. Furthermore the Koran reminds the Jews and the Christians many times that our mutual father was Abraham who believed and worshiped the one and only one God.

Koran 3:64 Say, "O followers of the scripture (Jews and Christians), let us come to a logical agreement between us and you: that we shall not worship except God; that we never set up any idols besides Him, nor set up any human beings as lords beside God....
